IAR-DST training workshops for GPs and mental healthcare workers

The Initial Assessment and Referral Decision Support Tool (IAR-DST) for mental health care assists general practitioners and clinicians in recommending a level of care for a person seeking mental health support.



The IAR- DST:

- provides a framework for GPs and clinicians to consider consumers presentation in the context of 8 holistic assessment domains and may also act as a prompt about the information to gather.
- aims to provide: a common approach and language for communicating the intensity of the treatment response (level of care) across service providers.

The 2-hour training will focus on:

- 1. Introduction to the IAR-DST and the development of the National Guidance.
- 2. Orientation to the domains, levels of care, and Decision Support Tool.
- 3. Clinical judgement and supported decision-making.
- 4. Practical application of the IAR-DST using a training scenario.

A once off \$300 payment (excl. GST) is available for eligible GPs who complete the two-hour training*.
