

PDSA: Increasing the uploading of Shared Health Summaries to the My Health Record for all patients over the age of 65 years.

Having a Shared Health Summary uploaded to the My Health Record will enable better care coordination between providers. The most viewed Shared Health Summaries by a local health network was for patients over the age of 65 years. Having immediate access to information in My Health Record at point of care enables providers to focus on providing the best possible care (especially in an emergency situation).

Idea: All patients over 65 years who have a My Health Record should have a Shared Health Summary uploaded to the My Health Record. Opportunistically upload Shared Health Summaries to the My Health Record for patients over the age of 65 years when they are attending for care and vaccinations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all clinical staff are trained on using the process of uploading SHS. (Training is available on the use of My Health Record) at this Link • Ensure all staff have access to the My Health Record through the Clinical Information System. • Educate all practice staff on how and why this is important. • Track numbers in the POLAR.

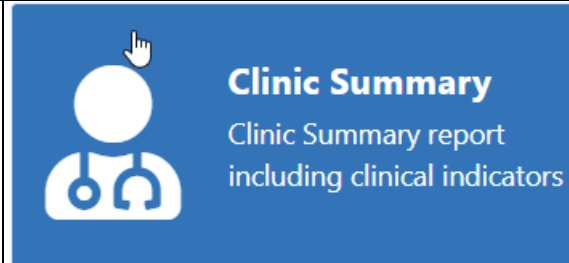

POLAR Walkthrough

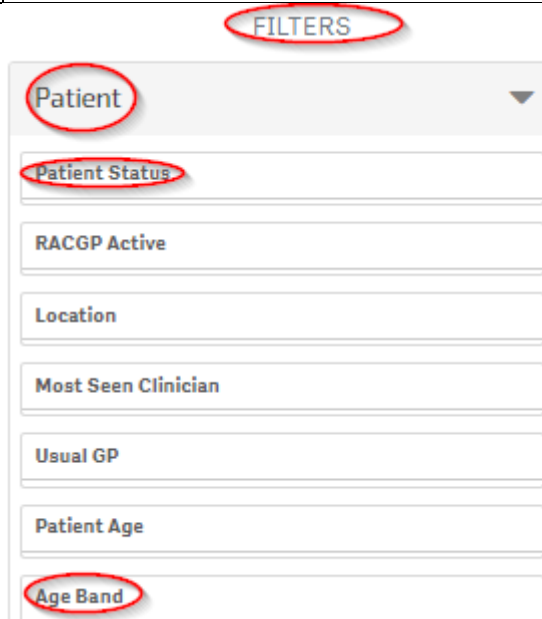
Patient Cohort: Active Patients over 65 years who have had a SHS uploaded to the My Health Record

1. Open POLAR and Select Clinic Summary Report

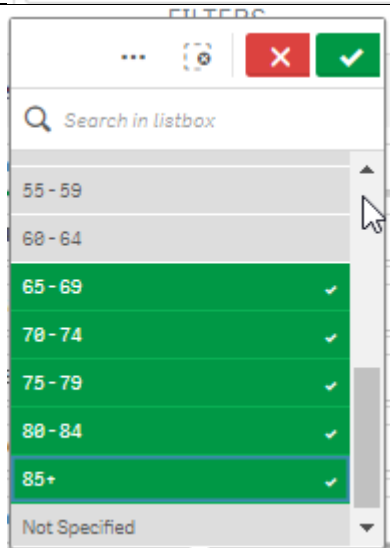


2. Select Patient Filters from the left hand side then

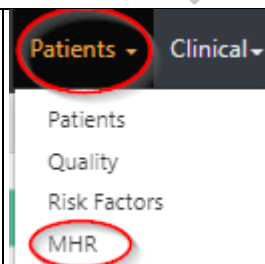
Patient Status and select Active and confirm the selection then select Age Band and select >65 and confirm the selection
