



While all patients are eligible to register for MyMedicare from 1/10/23 some practices may choose to prioritise patients that are in higher risk groups. This Walkthrough will identify patients that are most at risk of being hospitalised: Note it will identify patients who have been 3 or more times in the previous 2 years but it will not identify if these are face to face consultations you will need to check your billing software to confirm.
